GERMAN TEACHERS' INTERVIEW

Simone, what kind of subjects do you teach?

I give mathematics, English and Art.

What do you think about the Comenius Project?

Our teachers and students like the Project very much. Pupils love Leo & Lea and they are very happy when the squirrel is in our school.

Were you willing to come to Spain?

Yes, we wanted to come to Spain because we like it very much. And we like your school and your students are very nice.

Is there anything you would like to know about Spain?

We have been in Spain before but not in this area. Tomorrow we want to go to Madrid and then we want to see the city. We've got a sightseeing tour, I think so. And then we will learn new things about Madrid and Spain.

Can you tell us some typical German food?

Yes. Normally German people eat a lot of meat and we love potatoes. So we eat potato salad with sausages. And on Sunday most Germans eat potatoes, vegetables and meat ("Schnitzel").

How many holidays have you got in Germany?

We have got lots of holidays. We have winter holidays, Christmas holidays, spring holidays, summer holidays and autumn holidays.

Your holidays are completely different to ours. Could you tell us how many weeks off have you got?

In summer we have got six weeks holidays. At the beginning of August we begin with the school. So we start very early. At this time you are still on holidays. Then we have one week off in October, two weeks during Christmas time and one week in February. Then we have some days around Easter and one week in May.

How many pupils are there in your school?



In our school we have got 160 pupils and twelve teachers.

How old is your school?

Our school is over 100 years old.

What do you think about our school?

We think that your school is very nice; it's very new and we like your big hall. We like it as well because you've got lots of decoration on the walls.

Kerstin, what are your impressions about our school?

I have travelled to many countries and as far as I am concerned the Spanish school is the best one. (*"Ich habe viele Länder kennengelernt und finde die Spanische Schule am besten".*)

Angelika, what do you think about your visit to Spain?

I am impressed because the children are always laughing and they are really nice. They look happy and this is great! (*Und mir fällt auf, dass die*
