

SCHOOL INFORMATION

- It is located in the Austrian Dynasty area. Surrounded by historical and artistic building; first of Alfonso VI Street.
- 3 class groups in Infant Education and 6 in Primary.
- It has got an English Department, Library, computer room, assembly, workshop, music room, staff room, gym, indoor and outdoor playground, canteen and kitchen.
- It has got a wide range of material resources (from electronic devices to school material), which are well exploited.
- Schedule: Morning from 9 to 12:30. Afternoons: from 14:30 to 16 Extended: from 8 to 9 and from 16 to 17.

TEACHING STAFF

- There are 9 class teachers and 6 specialist for: Music, Religion, P.E. Art, I.T. and library attendance.
- Four highly qualified English teachers develop the Bilingual Project, together with three British and American teacher assistants.

PUPILS

- There are 211 pupils; 40 per cent of them are immigrants of 12 different nationalities.

SUBJECTS IN ENGLISH

- In Infant Education, 5 years old, children have a daily session in English.
- 1st cycle children are taught in English while working on: reading and writing, art, knowledge of the world, Music and Physical Education.
Gradually 1 more group each year (5 years old next year) will learn in English for at least one third of the total time spent at school.

- Year III, IV and V have their regular E.F.L. (English as a Foreign Language) lessons (one per day). And they have Art, Knowledge of the World and Physical Education in english.

BILINGUAL ENVIROMENT

- A teaching staff attends a weekly workshop to assure each teacher has a contribution to the bilingual project, through tasks like signalling corridors and classrooms,

SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL PROJECT

- Enhancing good relationships among all members of the school community as well as with the nearby institutions.
- Fostering systematic work and discipline
- Developing a class-teacher action-plan oriented to: the pupil integration, learning to interact and learning to learn strategies.

EVALUATION

- Pupils are officially assessed each term through written reports that teachers personally hand out to parents.

OTHER LEARNING EXPERIENCES

- The school is involved in Europeans projects since 1999

PARENTS RELATIONSHIP

- In addition to general meeting and visiting hours, teachers and head team will facilitate any interview so as to promote communication and efficiency.
- The parent association is very active and close to the teaching staff. They provide a wide choice of after-school activities and manage the extended school schedule (from 8 to 9 and 16 to 15).

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

- Exchange program with a school from Liverpool (Green Park) and a school from Halifax (Christ Church Junior School).
- Educational visits: museums, natural setting, theatre plays, concerts,
- School festivals: Christmas, San Ildefonso, San Isidro
- School exchanges with other Regions
- Snow week in the Pyrenees mountain
- School open-days.
